DRESS CODE AND UNIFORM PACKET
2009-2010

Attention Adelphi Families:

Enclosed you will find your dress Code and Uniform Packet. It includes the Adelphi Academy 2009-2010 Dress Code regulations, your Lands' End School Catalog and the Uniform Options Sheet for all students.

Please be advised when ordering from the Lands' End Catalog that there are very different and distinct uniforms for Lower, Middle and Upper School students. Some items apply to all three, but not all.

When placing your order with Lands' End **you must tell Lands' End that you are calling to place an order from Adelphi Academy and give them the School Number (9000-4790-3)**. You must also let Lands' End know whether you will be placing an order for a Lower, Middle or Upper School student.

Additionally, please be advised that **the Adelphi Academy School Crest is mandatory on all Land's End clothing** unless otherwise indicated on the enclosed Uniform Options Sheet. Adelphi Academy realizes that from time to time the Lands' End Company can indeed get backed up in their processing and shipping of orders. Therefore, with proper written notification from their parents/guardians to the Academy and only if absolutely necessary, Lower, Middle and Upper School students will be given a two (2) week grace period (Monday, September 9th, 2009 – Friday, September 18th, 2009) to be in full uniform. Until that time, students are still expected to be in proper dress code and be neat and presentable at all times. This grace period is only extended to those families who have uniform items on backorder from the company. Proof will be required. **After the date of the 18th, no further exceptions will be made under any circumstances.** Students found to be out of uniform after the date of September 18th, 2009 will not be admitted into class and parents/guardians will be contacted and asked to make arrangements for the student.

All male Lower, Middle and Upper School students are required to wear the age appropriate Embroidered Adelphi Academy Student Tie and are required to purchase a minimum of two (2) ties each year, through Mr. Kain's office at a cost of \$35.00 for clip-on ties and \$42.00 for neck ties. Accounts will automatically be billed.

Dress Code and Uniform Code

2009-2010

Everyone at Adelphi including students, are expected to dress in a fashion consistent with accepted casual and profession attire. The expectation is that students will respect their school and demonstrate that respect in their attire and presentation.

Appropriate grooming, presentation and dress are essential elements in a viable private college preparatory school. The Administration determines the dress code. It is to be noted that the Dean of Students is the final arbitrator of dress code. Please be aware that any violations of the dress code and school uniform will result in a phone call home as well as an immediate detention issued to the student for the same day. Violations of the dress code and school uniform may also cause a student to be sent home and/or to be suspended from attending classes for the day. Additionally, if a student reports to class out of dress code, that student will be marked by his or her teacher as "unprepared for class," which will impact on the student's daily class grade, which in turn will also impact on their trimester, and final grades in those classes for those marking periods. Furthermore each time a student is out of dress code a notice will be placed in that student's file.

The dress code is in effect at all times during the academic day. Even students remaining after school or attending school sponsored trips or events, either on or off of the school premises are expected to be in appropriate attire at all times. An Adelphi Academy student is expected to be neat and clean at all times.

Lower, Middle and Upper School – Pre-Kindergarten through 12th Year

All Lower, Middle and Upper School students are required to wear the mandatory school uniform which must be purchased through your Lands' End catalogue. This uniform includes for boys, dress pants, dress shirts, dress shoes, dress socks, dress belts and dress sweaters. Girls' uniforms include collared blouses, jumpers, skirts, dress shoes, dress socks, and dress sweaters.

Lower School students may wear the required uniform for Physical Education class (included in the cost of the annual student fees) for the entire day, on the day that the class is scheduled.

All Students – Pre-Kindergarten through 12th Year

All students from Pre-Kindergarten through 12th Year must wear the required school Physical Education uniform. This uniform must be ordered using the enclosed form through the Athletics/Physical Education Office. The cost of this gym uniform is included in the cost of the annual mandatory student fees listed in each family's enrollment contract. The form must be completed and returned to the Main Office by September 8th, 2009. Any student who does not return the form by the indicated due date will not receive a Physical Education Uniform. Additional uniforms including athletic sweat pants, sweat shirts, hooded sweat shirts, shorts and t-shirts may also be purchased through the office at an additional cost per item. Any student who is not in full Physical Education uniform while attending a scheduled Physical Education class at Adelphi will be considered "unprepared for class" and receive an "F" for the day as well as an immediate detention. The student will also not be permitted to participate in the class for that day. Please be advised that Physical Education Uniforms will not be distributed until the end of October. Until then, students are expected to be in full athletic attire for Physical Education class.

Lower, Middle and Upper School – Pre-Kindergarten through 12th Year

Fall/Spring Dress Code: Monday, September 9th, 2009 – Friday, October 30th, 2009 and Monday, March 29th, 2010 – Friday, June 11th, 2010

Boys must wear a collard, uniform button down, short sleeve dress shirt, or a uniform short sleeve golf shirt, uniform dress pants, a uniform dress belt, uniform dress socks and uniform dress shoes. All shirts must be tucked in at all times. All uniform clothing must be traditional in cut, size and fit and purchased from Land's End. Jeans, jean cut pants or jackets of any kind, or cargo pants are not permitted. No sneakers, hats of any kind or logos are permitted. No athletic wear or sweat clothes or warm up clothes of any kind are permitted except for the appropriate athletic uniform during a scheduled Physical Education class or athletic event. Earrings, visible body piercings, excessively long hair, tattoos and fashion accessories are considered inappropriate for school and are not permitted at any time. Outer coats, jackets and book-bags must be left in lockers and/or classroom cubbies.

Girls must wear uniform skirts, a uniform button down short sleeve dress shirts or a uniform short sleeve golf shirt, uniform dress socks and uniform dress shoes. All skirts must be no higher than 2" above the knee. **If a young lady is addressed regarding the length of her skirt more than once, a parent will be contacted and required to pick her up from school for the day.** No part of a young ladies chest or stomach should be exposed at any time. All shirts must be tucked in at all times. All uniform clothing must be traditional in cut, size and fit and purchased from Land's End. Excessively tight clothing of any kind is not permitted at any time. Jeans, jean cut pants or jackets of any kind, or cargo pants are not permitted. No sneakers, hats of any kind or logos are permitted. No athletic wear, sweat clothes, warm up clothes of any kind or spandex are permitted except for the appropriate athletic uniform during a scheduled Physical Education class or athletic event. Earrings may only be worn in the ear. Visible body piercings are not permitted in school at any time. Excessive jewelry, make-up, hair styling, fashion accessories and tattoos are considered inappropriate for school and are not permitted at any time. Outer coats, jackets, book-bags and pocketbooks must be left in lockers and/or classroom cubbies.

Winter Dress Code: Monday, November 2nd, 2009 – Friday, March 26th, 2010

Boys same as Fall/Spring Dress Code. However, all shirts must be long sleeve and the school tie must be worn at all times with all uniform collard, button down, dress shirts. Uniform turtleneck shirts are permitted and uniform sweaters may be worn over a uniform button down, golf or turtle neck shirt.

Girls same as Fall/Spring Dress Code. However uniform sweaters may be worn over uniform collared or golf shirts.

Please be advised: Students are strictly prohibited from wearing non uniform cloths to school and changing into school uniforms after arriving to school in the morning.

Please note: When the "Assembly Dress Code" is in effect for Wednesday Assemblies and special events, all male students are required to wear the uniform collared, button down shirt and uniform tie throughout the year. Students will always be given notice of Assembly Dress Code requirements for special events.
