Attention Adelphi Families:

Every Adelphi Academy student is required to have an annual medical examination by a Medical Doctor or Licensed Health Care Practitioner before beginning classes each year. Additionally, all Adelphi Academy students are required to be in compliance with New York City Health Code rules regarding physical examinations and required immunization. Adelphi's Student Medical and Immunization Records Form must be completed by a Medical Doctor or Licensed Health Care Practitioner and must include proof that the immunization requirements have been satisfied.

Any students interested in participating in any extra curricular interscholastic athletics at Adelphi are also required to have an annual physical examination to certify that they are able to participate in the program.

Any Adelphi Academy student entering Pre-Kindergarten must also complete a New York City Department of Health Bureau of Day Care Children's Medical Record. If this applies to your child please contact the Academy to obtain the proper forms.

Any Adelphi Academy student entering a New York City school for the first time must also complete a New York City New Admission Examination Form. If this applies to your child please contact the Academy to obtain the proper forms.

According to the New York State Public Health Law and to protect all of the students and staff of Adelphi Academy, **students who have not provided the school with all of the proper medical records will not be permitted to attend Adelphi Academy until such proof is submitted.**
